

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WHEEL LANE, PILLING, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wheel Lane, Pilling from its junction with Duck Street to a point approximately 140 metres north of its junction with Hooles Lane.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Monday 8th July 2024 until Tuesday 9th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Fluke Hall Lane – School Lane – Smallwood Hey Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cabling and desilting works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
